Haida Tourism LP Request for Proposal- Marine Transportation Services

Background Information

Haida Tourism LP (HTLP)

Is currently seeking proposals from Haida/local entrepreneurs capable of facilitating scheduled marine tours with up to 12 passengers in the Englefield Bay vicinity on the west coast of Moresby Island. The objective of the proposal is to provide an opportunity for a local business to partner with HTLP in its latest offering via The Ocean House at STADS K'UNS GAWGA, *PEEL INLET*. In addition to the Ocean House Haida Tourism currently operates The Haida House at Tllaal as well as Westcoast Resorts the Lodge at Englefield Bay and the Lodge at Hippa Island. Haida Tourism is a subsidiary of the Haida Enterprise Corporation (HaiCo) along with Haida Wild Seafoods and Taan Forest.

The proposal will need to include the following Information -Company Information

- Vessel Information (Year/Make/Model/Seating Capacity/Fuel Capacity/Consumption)
- Engine Information(Year/Make/Model/Hours)
- Transport Canada Certificates of Operator(s) (SVOP/MED's/ROC-M/Marine First Aid)
- Proof of Insurance
- Operators marine experience
- Daily Cost to facilitate transportation
- Copies of current permits into Gwaii Haanas and/or Protected Area/s

Scope of Work

As part of the Ocean House package, guests will have an opportunity to take in the rugged west coast of Haida Gwaii. Currently tour locations associated with this proposal will be: Kaisun, Security Inlet, Buck Channel (permits pending). The



interested parties will be responsible for the safe, efficient transportation to these locations. The operator will be responsible for the provisioning (fuel, oils, safety equipment) maintenance, cleanliness and operations of the vessel.

Haida Tourism will provide accommodations and meals for the operator as well as appropriate moorage of the operator's vessel. Throughout the operating season at Oceanhouse, HTLP will facilitate guest transfers on Wednesday and Sundays via Helicopter from Sandspit. This allows for potential operator transfers in season to and from the facility. While on site at the Ocean House facility all operators be under the direct supervision of the Lodge Managers and are expected to conduct themselves in friendly respectful manner with staff and guests at all times.

The Operating Season at the Ocean House will commence on June 1, 2018 and operate till September 9, 2018. The vessel and a qualified operator will need to be available for the entire duration of the operating season, 7 days a week. Your proposal should be based on and 8-10 hr work day consisting of multiple trips amongst the proposed destinations. Specific daily trips are subject to change based on bookings and weather conditions.
